- Candidates must hold at least a bachelor's degree in history or a closely related field
- A minimum of three years teaching experience is preferred
- A thorough knowledge of the discipline
- An understanding of the vital role of research, writing, and historical analysis in preparing students for the Upper School
- A familiarity and ease with integrating technology into the classroom
- An ability to collaborate effectively with members of the department and the Middle School faculty to enhance students' appreciation and understanding of history
- A desire to introduce multiple perspectives and a diverse set of backgrounds as they pertain to the topics and lessons
